### **CARE PLANNING AND MUSCULOSKELETAL HEALTH**

The central element of care planning is a collaborative, personalised care planning conversation, usually between a person with one or more long term conditions and a healthcare professional (or care and support worker) The conversation brings together information gathered by the healthcare professional and the perspectives of the person with the condition, to allow time for shared goal

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method of planning care that has changed over time (Walsh 1998) For example, consider a dressing change In the 1970s, the care was planned in the dressing book, the task ticked off once completed and plans made to repeat the care if required, with a further entry in the dressing book One can speculate that care plans may be required now more than ever, given the increased complexity of care
