The fight against tax evasion, shadow economy, digital shadow economy and illegal employment in the regions has become one of the most important tasks of most countries over the past year, as the lack of information on the level of shadow economy in the regions does not allow to choose effective measures to eliminate the consequences of shadow economy (Gasparyniene et al, 2017)

Estimating Factors Affecting Tax Evasion in Malaysia: A ...

One of the main causes of tax evasion is tax burden. Many researchers such as Brooks (2001), Savasan (2003), Dell'Anno (2007), Dell'Anno et al (2004), Schneider and Savasan (2007) showed that an increase in tax burden leads to high shadow economy and tax evasion. Bayer and Sutter (2008)
